Introduction

- 1. Thanksgiving is essential in all five spiritual sacrifices when we worship God.
 - a. Those five spiritual sacrifices are teaching/preaching, singing, giving, the Lord's Supper, and prayers (Ac. 2:42).
- 2. We express our thanksgiving to God and for others verbally through prayer.
- 3. We express our thanksgiving to God through our giving.
- 4. We express our thanksgiving for the great sacrifice of Jesus during the Lord's Supper.

I. Preaching and Teaching Are Essential

- 1. The church in prophesy (<u>Isa. 2:1-4</u>; cf. <u>Mic. 4:1-8</u>).
 - a. Teaching is an essential part of the church (Isa. 2:3; cf. Mic. 4:2).
 - b. Faith is produced by hearing the Word of God (Rm. 10:17).
- 2. Teaching is necessary if we wish to be saved (Jn. 6:44-45 citing Isa. 54:13; cf. Jn. 14:6).
- 3. God chose the Gospel which must be preached to save (Rm. 1:16-17; cf. 1 Cor. 1:18ff; Tt. 1:1-3).
 - a. We are called by the Gospel (2 Th. 2:13-15).
- 4. **Preach** and **doctrine** defined.
 - a. "...how shall they **preach**, except they be sent?..." (Rm. 10:15).
 - b. "...apostles' doctrine..." (Ac. 2:42).

II. The Function of Preaching and Teaching

- 1. Preaching and teaching **shapes** our hearts.
 - a. The first five books of the New Testament are designed to teach us how to get **into** Christ (Matthew Acts).
 - b. The 21 epistles which follow teach us how to **live** in Christ (Romans Jude).
 - c. Revelation teaches us how to **die** in Christ.
 - d. The grace of God teaches (Tt. 2:11-14).
- 2. Preaching and teaching **transforms** our lives as God would have them to be (Rm. 12:1-2).
 - a. A Christian is no longer a servant of sin but of righteousness (Rm. 6:16-18).

- 3. Preaching and teaching **promotes church growth** both numerically and spiritually.
 - a. Numerically (Ac. 2:41, 4:4, 5:14).
 - b. Spiritually (Ac. 9:31).
 - c. We need active listeners to what is being taught!

Conclusion

- 1. The whole counsel of God must be declared in preaching and teaching (<u>Ac.</u> <u>20:25-27</u>).
 - a. This includes thanksgiving which is necessary in our lives as Christians.
- 2. The Gospel changes people's lives and can transform a selfish, arrogant, prideful person into a selfless, humble, and thankful person.
 - a. Therefore, we preach and teach the Gospel!
